We are launching Programs of All Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) starting in in Stockton, California. PACE is an integrated health care model providing full medical and social support services to frail, elderly participants. Reporting directly to the Director of Marketing, the Enrollment RN is responsible for completing home assessments and required documentation on prospective enrollees and facilitating the enrollment process in a high growth atmosphere.

Responsibilities:

- Conducts full medical and environmental in-home assessments on prospective enrollees
- Completes level of care documentation and submits for the state (DHCS) review initially and as required annually
- Prepares and oversees the semi-annual level of care on-site audit in coordination with other interdisciplinary team members
- Presents prospective enrollee cases to the Interdisciplinary team as needed
- In coordination with the Interdisciplinary Team, develops a Plan of Care based on nursing process that incorporates immediate and continuing care needs and includes the participant and family perspective
- Prepares and oversees the semi-annual level of care on-site audit in coordination with other interdisciplinary team members
- Administers and completes the TB testing process for all perspective enrollees
- Educates the participant, family members and/or caregiver regarding the disease process, self-care techniques, and prevention strategies
- Provides community resources and referrals as necessary prior to enrollment
- As needed in the clinic, provides direct care that includes drawing lab orders, blood sugar checks, wound care, and/or identified follow-up needs
- Identifies emergency situations and takes appropriate action, including coordinating emergency services from home as appropriate

Qualifications:

- Graduate of an accredited school of professional nursing
- RN currently licensed by the California Board of Registered Nursing
- At least two years nursing employment with experience in home health setting and/or conducting home visits with the geriatric population
- Comfort with completing assessments routinely in the participants' residence
- Ability to work well both independently and within an Interdisciplinary Team
- Highly motivated, self-directed, able to execute tasks in a quickly changing environment
- Strong customer service, enterprising, growth-minded orientation
