



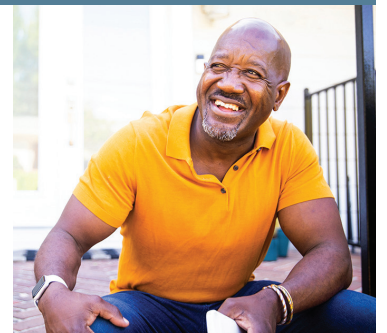
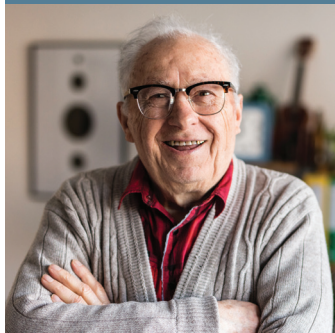

WelbeHealth's PACE services provide care and services in the home, the community, and at our Day Centers. We have contracts with many specialists and other providers in the community to make sure participants get the care they need. Our centers meet state and federal safety requirements and include adult day programs, medical clinics, activities, and occupational and physical therapy facilities.

Our unique approach delivers comprehensive care for California's seniors, including but not limited to:

- Primary Care (including doctor and nursing services)
- Hospital care
- Medical specialty services
- Prescription drugs
- Nursing home care
- Emergency services
- Home care
- Physical therapy
- Occupational therapy
- Adult day care
- Recreational therapy
- Meals
- Dentistry
- Nutritional counseling
- Social services
- Laboratory/ X-ray services
- Social work counseling
- Transportation



WelbeHealth's PACE also includes all other services determined as necessary by the member's team of healthcare professionals to improve and maintain their overall health.

The participant's PACE doctor and other care providers are also the people who work with them to make decisions about their care.

No higher authorities will overrule what the members, their doctor, and other care providers agree is best for them. If a member disagrees with the interdisciplinary team about their care plan, they have the right to file an appeal.

Preventive care is covered and encouraged.

The focus of WelbeHealth's PACE is to help members live in the community for as long as possible. To meet this goal, we focus on preventive care.

WelbeHealth's PACE also provides members with medical transportation, along with all medically necessary transportation to our Day Centers for activities or medical appointments. Members can also get transportation to appointments in the community.

WelbeHealth's PACE program is designed for qualifying seniors who:

- ✔ Are age 55 or older
- ✔ Are able to live safely at home
- ✔ Live within one of the PACE eligible zip codes
- ✔ Are willing to relocate to PACE eligible zip codes
- ✔ Have difficulty with ADLs (activities of daily living)
- ✔ Have chronic medical conditions
- ✔ Have Medi-Cal or are willing to apply for Medi-Cal

WelbeHealth PACE uses Medicare and Medi-Cal funds to cover all medically necessary care and services (including prescription drugs). Seniors can have either Medicare or Medi-Cal, or both, to join PACE. If they do not have Medi-Cal, they may pay a small premium.

Fewer nursing home admissions

Despite being at a nursing home level of care, PACE participants have a low risk of being admitted to a nursing home.

PACE enrollees are less likely to suffer depression

27% of new PACE enrollees scored as depressed on an assessment administered before enrollment. Nine months later, 80% of those assessed as depressed no longer scored as depressed.
