PACE Program WelbeHealth's Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly **(PACE)** is a health plan model that helps seniors meet their health care needs in the community instead of going to a nursing home or other care facility.

WelbeHealth's PACE services provide care and services in the home, the community, and at our Centers. We have contracts with many specialists and other providers in the community to make sure participants get the care they need. **Our centers meet state** and federal safety requirements and include adult day programs, medical clinics, activities, and occupational and physical therapy facilities.

Our unique approach delivers comprehensive care for California's seniors, including but not limited to:

- Primary Care (including doctor and nursing services)
- Hospital care
- Medical specialty services
- Prescription drugs
- Nursing home care

WelbeHealth's PACE also includes all other services determined as necessary by the member's team of healthcare professionals to improve and maintain their overall health. The participant's PACE doctor and other care providers are also the people who work with them to make decisions about their care. No higher authorities will overrule what the members, their doctor, and other care providers agree is best for them. If a member disagrees with the interdisciplinary team about their care plan, they have the right to file an appeal.

Preventive care is covered and encouraged.

The focus of WelbeHealth's PACE is to help members live in the community for as long as possible. To meet this goal, we focus on preventive care.

WelbeHealth's PACE also provides members with medical transportation, along with all medically necessary transportation to our Centers for activities or medical appointments. Members can also get transportation to appointments in the community.

WelbeHealth's PACE program is designed for qualifying seniors who:

- Live within one of the PACE eligible zip codes
- Are willing to relocate to PACE eligible zip codes
- Have difficulty with ADLs (activities of daily living)
- ☆ Have Medi-Cal or are willing to apply for Medi-Cal

WelbeHealth uses Medicare and Medi-Cal funds to cover medically necessary care and services (including prescription drugs). Seniors can have either Medicare or Medi-Cal, or both, to join PACE. If they do not have Medi-Cal, they may pay a small premium.
